

2017 Sheepvention Primary School Competition

Entries Close July 28th



Competition Overview

All contestants need to come up with a healthy version of a popular fast food item the Burger. Students would need to send through a recipe together with a video of them preparing their entry. Judges will examine the recipes as well as the videos awarding points for each marking criteria to ascertain a winner. A Grand Prize will be awarded to the winning child's school, being a Bubble Muffin Food Science show, the winning design will also be featured on the Bubble Muffin™ website, with an article in our online magazine with the winning contestant. Prizes for runner up entry as well.

Competition Guidelines

- Design a healthy version of a burger.
- All entries need to include Lamb in their recipe.
- Entries open to all primary school aged (and attending) children.
- Entries can be from individual students, pairs, groups or classes etc. Those in younger grades may prefer to do as a class project whereas older students may like to work in smaller groups or pairs.
- The components of a burger need to include:
 1. An outer casing such as a bun
 2. A salad component
 3. Lamb
 4. Cheese component
- Every entrant needs to supply a:
 - Recipe (original)
 - Video – preparation of the recipe 1 minute max.
 - Costing's of their recipe – what does your burger cost, individualised

NOTE: The aim is to create something healthy and different, based on the concept of the Burger, as long as you include the 4 main components you are in the running. We are looking for the healthiest, craziest design, something that is outa this world! Be as inventive and imaginative as you can, remember though to include the 4 main components!

Judging Criteria

We are not looking for perfection but rather inventiveness there are 4 main judging areas, listed below which each will be marked between 0 – 10, with a total score of 40 points.

The judging criteria is as follows:

1. *Imagination* |How creative is the burger, how different can you make it.
2. *Balance* |How you blend the health benefits of particular ingredients with flavours & textures.
3. *Technique* |What cooking techniques and preparation techniques are used in the preparation of this recipe.
4. *Fun* |How can you make this fun for those eating the burger.

Judges will each mark the entries with the marks tallied at the end of all judges. The judge's decision is final and binding, there will be no discussion entered into.
